28. TO RECEIVE ANY CORRESPONDENCE – CLERK TO REPORT ON GARDEN OF REMEMBRANCE AREA

The clerk reported she has received complaints regarding the garden of remembrance section, a significant increase of objects including glass lanterns, solar lights, glass picture frames, memorial plaques, wind chimes, kerb sets, have been placed on several graves, some of which are encroaching on neighbouring plots. It was reported that a glass object had broken which had resulted in a member of the public being injured. A discussion followed that the rules of the cemetery had been in place for a number of years and signage is visible from the entrance of the cemetery stating the rules. It was resolved that members request the clerk write to the next of kin of deed owners and request all unauthorised objects are removed within fourteen days. Council to arrange removal if not carried out. Also, an article to be placed in the next issue of the community news.

The clerk reported she had received another complaint regarding flower cuttings which are being left on the ground and onto one grave which is causing a great deal of distress to a family, letters have previously been issued to neighbouring plots of the families grave asking could all cuttings please be placed in the bins provided.
