7.CORRESPONDENCE

The following lights had been reported to the Clerk:

Back of 11 Glaslyn - manhole cover missing
column 455 Dinas - light out
column 387 Oak Road Acrefair - light out
column 154 Crane Street - leading to High Street - light out

Councillor B Cook questioned if the columns listed were now repaired. The Clerk advised if the fault is due to a Scottish Power failure, then repair can take up to twenty-one working days. All faults reported to the lighting contractor will be attended to within five working days and repaired on the initial call out unless parts must be ordered which can take an additional few days.

8.REPORTS FROM MEMBERS

8.1 The Clerk updated members following minute ref 32.1 that she had spoken to WCBC about the concerns raised regarding the replacement LED lights, it

was reported that the relevant surveys had been carried out prior to the installation, all lights conform to standards.

8.2 The Clerk reported she is in the process of obtaining prices for custom designed Christmas themed lighting to be erected on the George Edwards Hall. It was reported that permission from WCBC would be granted to erect additional Christmas lights in the community providing each column is surveyed for health & safety purposes and installed with a GRP box, this would be at a cost of approximately £150 per column.
